How this artist makes art out of what she can see out of her window.

Make

A 'viewfinder' and paint what you see.

- Fold the card in half and cut a square out of the middle.
- Use it to zoom in on a view in your home, or out of your window.
- Take your time to draw what you see on the blank postcard. Add colour with your paints.
- You only need to add a tiny bit of water to your brush to bring these paints to life.
- Leave it flat to dry.

Share

On the other side of the postcard, write a little story inspired by what you've painted.

Start with the sentence: *One day I was looking out of the window (or whatever your painting zooms in on!) when all of a sudden...*

Send your postcard to a pal, pop it through a neighbours' letterbox or leave it outside for someone to find.
