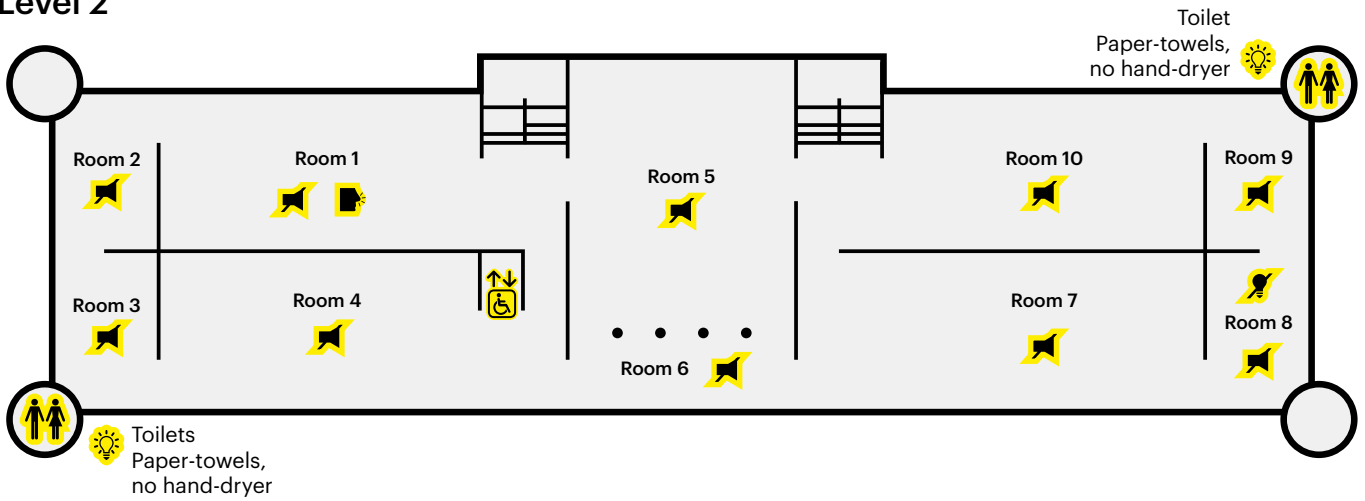


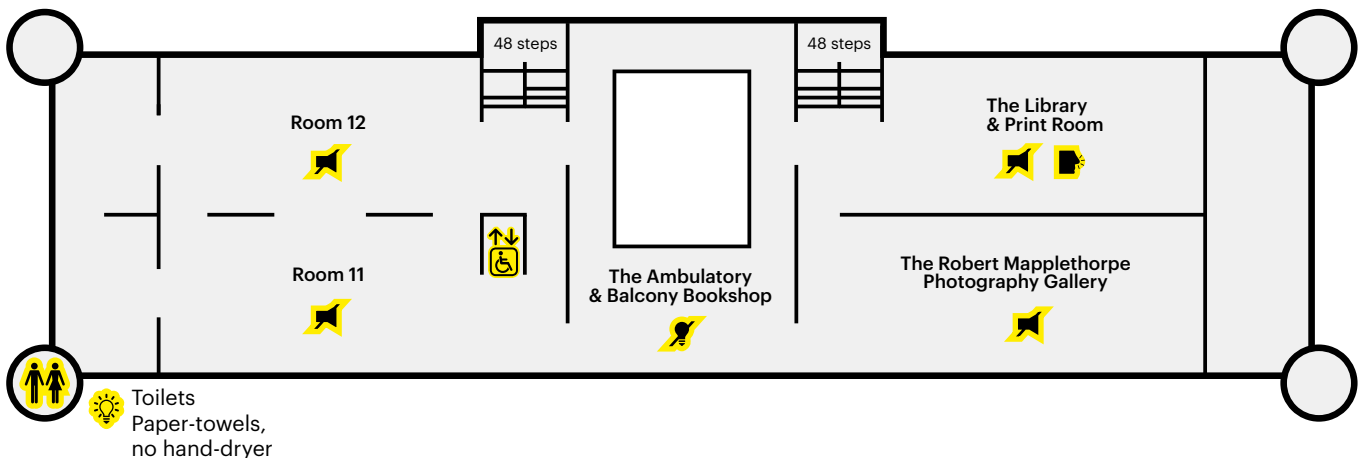

Sensory Map

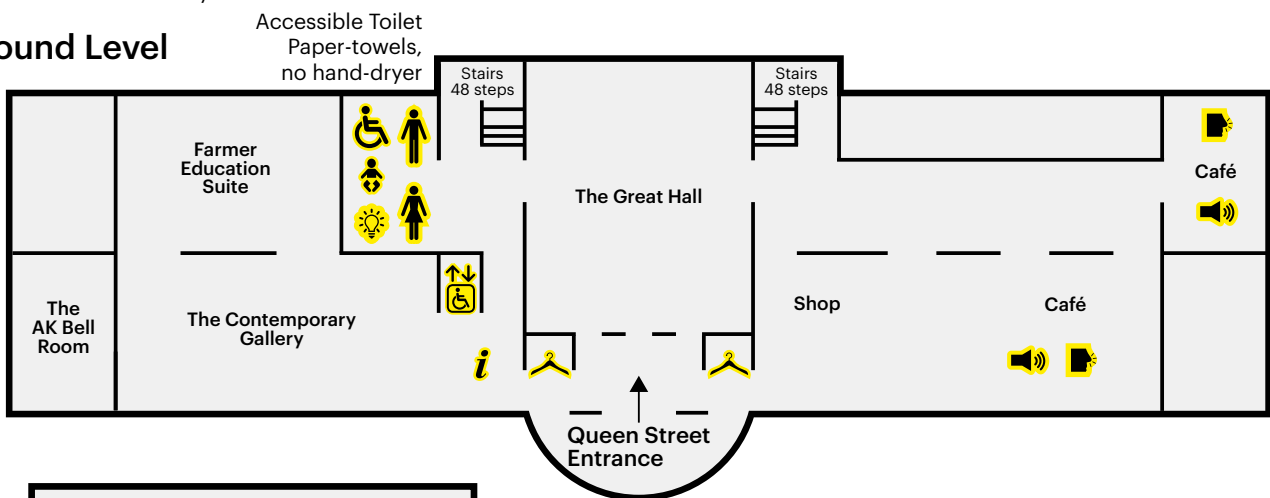
Level 2
