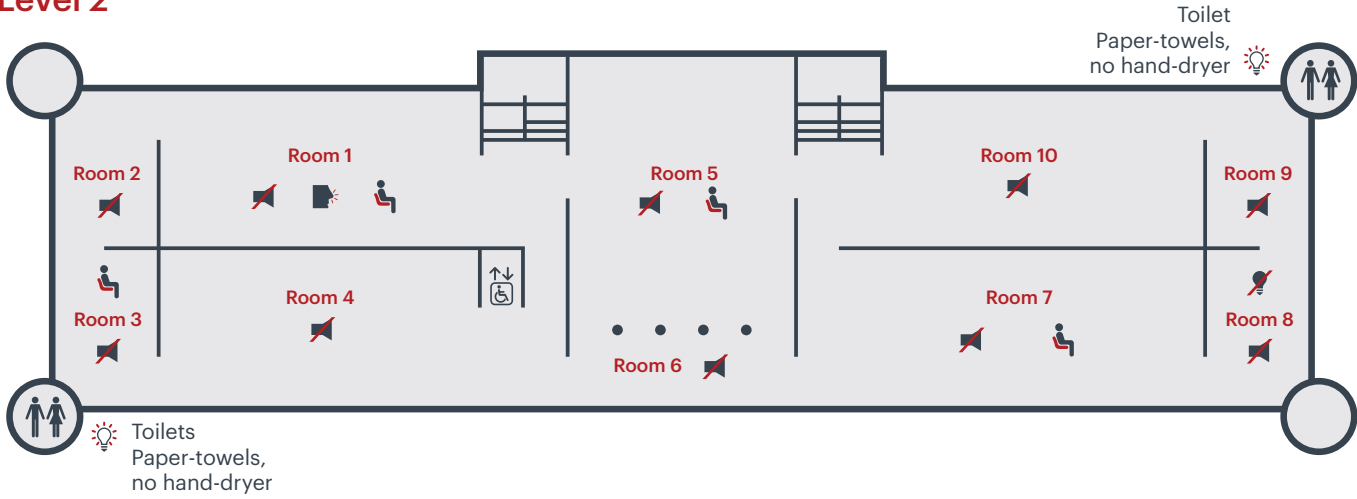


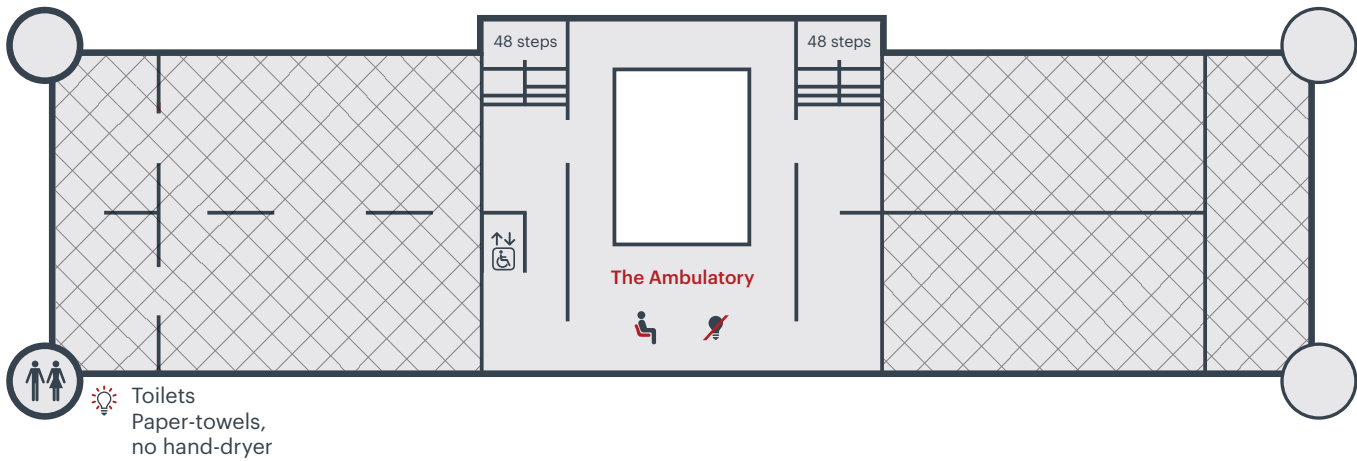
# Scottish National Portrait Gallery
